1. World: Your Kingdom come, You will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven.

- a. On this second Sunday of Advent, we pray for peace in places all around the world that are marred with conflict and wars. We pray for healing and restoration for the people on both side affected by the Israel-Gaza War.
- b. Ask God for wisdom and discernment for world leaders as they continue to dialogue and work together. Pray that countries will continue to care and provide for the weak and vulnerable, while also learning to preserve God's creation and God's world.
- c. Pray for Christians who are persecuted in the world, that God's Shalom will comfort them as they remember the hope of Christ in this advent season.

2. Singapore: Give us today our daily bread.

- a. Ask for God to continue to guard the peace that we have in Singapore, that our leaders will lead wisely as they navigate us through difficult challenges.
- b. Pray for God's peace and reconciliation to re-unite families that are estranged and mend relationships that are broken.
- c. Pray for business owners, workers and individuals struggling in the current economic situation. Pray for

God's mercy and provision as they continue to labor and find ways to survive.

3. TPMC: Forgive us our debts as we have also forgiven our debtors. Lead us not into temptations but deliver us from evil

- a. Pray that God will reveal to us the areas of our lives that we have been peacemakers. We ask for God's forgiveness and seek to live in peace with one another.
